If elevated moisture levels are identified then walls and/or ceilings should be opened up to visually inspect and determine if hidden mold growth exists.	Completed
The source of the airborne fungal spores should be identified and mitigated, along with the corresponding source(s) of moisture.	Completed
A reassessment for the presence of CO should occur in and around the cluster of portable classrooms.	Completed
