As you know, Lime Kiln experienced a flood due to an overhead pipe failure on Monday, April 10, 2017. The purpose of this communication is to keep you informed of our progress in clean-up and repairs due to the collateral damage. This weekend, May 5-7, the carpet in all affected areas (Band, Orchestra and Music rooms, and front office suite) is being removed and replaced. The expectation is that there will be minimal, if any, disruption to instruction today and/or Monday. We thank all staff and students for their patience and flexibility in this process. Also this weekend, the flooring for the new gym floor is being delivered. It is expected that work to replace the gym floor will happen next week during the afterschool hours. We expect that the gymnasium will be able to be accessed for PE classes shortly thereafter. In order to expedite the ability to use the floor and gymnasium, once the floor is laid next week a temporary seal coat will be applied with no lines/markings painted. Over the summer, the floor will be finished with lines/markings and full seal coating. Thanks again to all staff, students and families for their flexibility and understanding as we have worked together to whether the disruptions caused by this building event. We hope to be back to full operation very soon!
